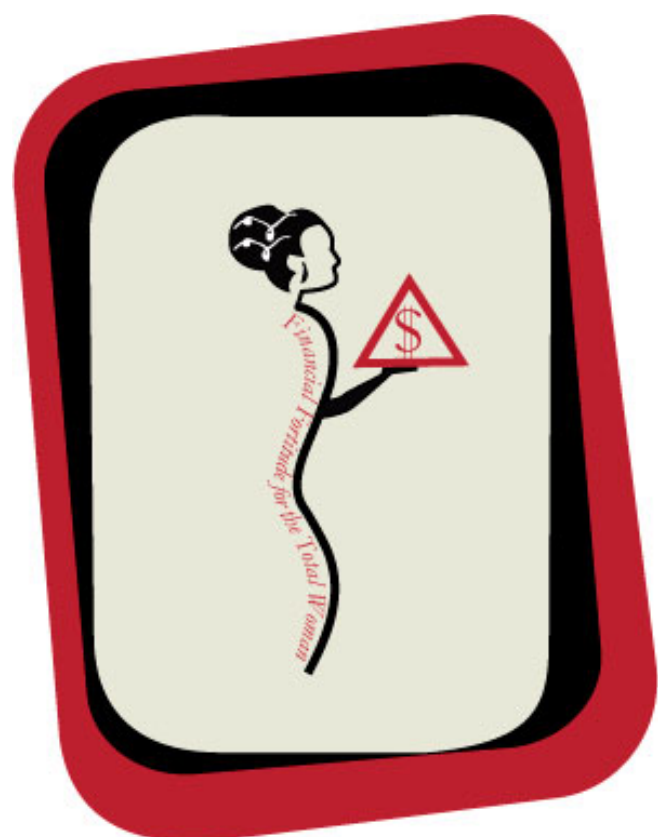

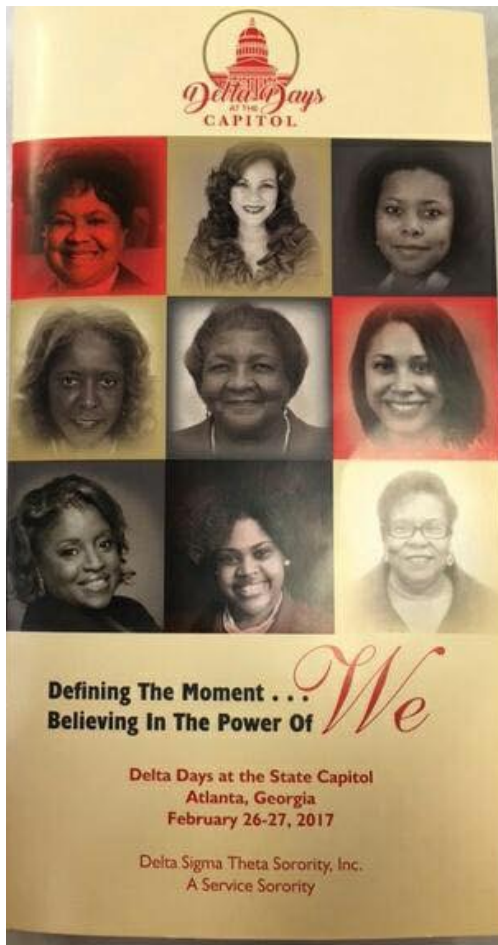

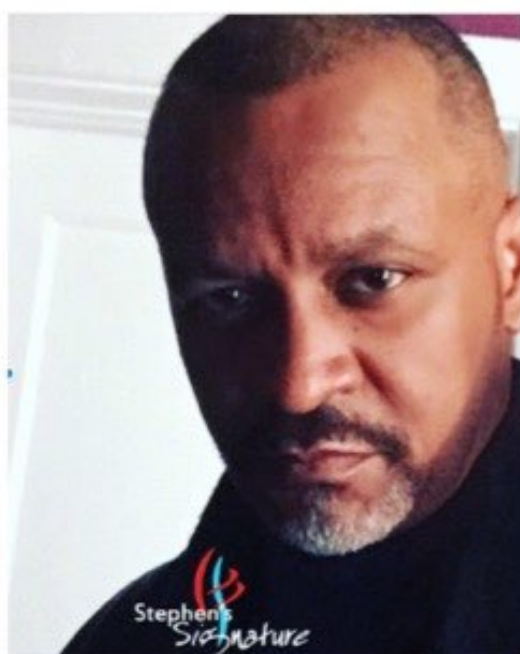
GEORGIA 2017 DELTA DAYS AT THE CAPITOL
